## FUNDING GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

### ELIGIBILITY

The Meigs County Community Fund [MCCF] was created in partnership with the Foundation for Appalachian Ohio, a regional community foundation working with Appalachian Ohio communities to grow local opportunities. MCCF is working to grow grantmaking dollars for projects that improve quality of life in Meigs County across five areas MCCF calls the Pillars of Prosperity: arts and culture, community and economic development, education, environmental stewardship, and health and human services. The Meigs County Community Fund is pleased to announce its inaugural request for mini-grant proposals serving the Meigs County community.

### FUNDING CRITERIA AND AVAILABILITY

Projects should increase quality of life, create access to opportunities or implement a solution for a need in Meigs County within one or more of the Pillars of Prosperity: arts and culture, community and economic development, education, environmental stewardship, and health and human services. At this time, the Foundation does **not** accept applications for any event sponsorships or sports-related requests.

For the inaugural round, grants will be considered up to \$5,000.

### HOW TO APPLY

In order to receive full consideration for funding, grant requests must include a completed application.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications will be accepted November 2, 2017 thru January 16, 2018, with all grant recipients notified by March 15, 2018. All grantees will be required to submit a final report at the conclusion of the project, including a detail of expenditures and photos.

All applications should be accurate, complete and include all required documentation at the time of submission to receive full consideration.
